| <b>Directions to Seneca Lake Camp:</b> | Use the address of the camp entrance.<br>4973 East Lake Rd., Romulus, New York, 14541  |
| <b>From the East</b>                   | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Take the Thruway (NYS Rt. 90) to exit 41, Rt 414</li> <li>2. Go South (right) after exiting the Thruway on Rt. 414 toward Waterloo</li> <li>3. Turn right onto Rt. 5 &amp; 20 (Toward Geneva)</li> <li>4. You will go through the town on Waterloo. You will see Rt.96 - that is NOT the correct road to take. Several miles later you will see a sign for Rt 96A toward Ithaca and Ovid.</li> <li>5. Turn left onto Rt 96A (South). Go approximately 1 mile on this road.</li> </ol> <p>Note - To avoid the 11'3" underpass on East Lake Road, stay on Rt. 96A to Yale Farm Rd (Rt. 127). Turn right on Yale Farm Road and continue with step 11.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>8. East Lake Road will bring you close to Seneca Lake.</li> <li>9. You will pass Yale Station Road.</li> <li>10. You will pass Yale Farm Road. 11. About 200 Yards past Yale Farm Road you will cross a small bridge. That creek is on the Camp property (to the left is the camp).</li> <li>12. There is a sign at the entrance to the camp and you will see the split rail fence and a gate and a large rock. Turn into the camp here.</li> </ol>  |
| <b>From the West</b>                   | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Take the Thruway (NYS Rt. 90) to exit 42</li> <li>2. Go South (right) after exiting the Thruway on Rt. 14 toward Geneva</li> <li>3. Go into Geneva to the first Traffic light.</li> <li>4. Turn left onto East North Street. This turns into Boarder City Road.</li> <li>5. Continue on Boarder City Road until it curves around a stop light at the Hess station. This is Rt. 5 &amp; 20</li> <li>6. Turn right onto Rt. 5 &amp; 20.</li> <li>7. Go 300 yards.</li> <li>8. Turn left onto Rt. 96A(South) Go approximately 1 mile on this road.</li> </ol> <p>Note - To avoid the 11'3" underpass on East Lake Road, stay on Rt. 96A to Yale Farm Road(RT. 127). Turn right on Yale Farm Road and continue with step 12.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>9. East Lake Road will bring you close to Seneca Lake.</li> <li>10. You will pass Yale Station Road.</li> <li>11. You will pass Yale Farm Road. 12. About 200 Yards past Yale Farm Road you will cross a small bridge. | <b>From the South</b>                  | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Proceed Norht to Ithaca via Rt. 17 &amp; 96.</li> <li>2. Continue on Rt. 96 North from Ithaca.</li> <li>3. In Ovid take Rt. 96A North, up the eastern shore of Seneca Lake.</li> <li>4. Turn left at Yale Farm Road(Rt. 127). this will take you to the lake.</li> <li>5. Turn Left onto East Lake road.</li> <li>6. About 200 Yards past Yale Farm Road you will cross a small bridge. That creek is on the Camp property (to the left is the camp).</li> <li>12. There is a sign at the entrance to the camp and you will see the split rail fence and a gate and a large rock. Turn into the camp here.</li> </ol>  |
